

Full participation in BMC includes (but not limited to):

1. Attending a 1-hour lecture and completing an online review of the lecture at every session. Missing any lecture will require a make-up (by completing a homework given on the following week). In the case where candidates are unable to meet attendance requirement, their Baptism/Membership may be put on hold.
2. Reading the *Methodist Social Principles* upon registration.
3. Reading relevant chapters of the *Church Membership Manual*, prior to attending each lecture.
4. Participating in small group discussion at every session, which requires the following preparation: 30 minutes of five daily readings, followed by reflection and journaling, guided by the workbook "*A Disciple's Path*."
5. Meeting a Pastor or Pastoral Team Member for Pastoral Conversation.
6. Meeting Pastors for an official lunch/dinner, typically in tandem with one of the sessions.
7. Serving at one TSS or an alternative P&P Service, either as an Usher/Tech Support/F&B Support.
8. Attending a Prayer Retreat.
9. Attending the Baptism Service (for candidates seeking baptism) on-site at Wesley Methodist Church.
10. Attending the Confirmation and Reception Into Membership (CARIM) Service on-site at Wesley Methodist Church.
11. Submitting the following documents in a timely manner:
 - a. Application online form
 - b. Baptism & Membership online form
 - c. Recent colour passport size photo
 - d. Image of front & back of NRIC/Passport.
 - e. Baptism Certificate (if applicable)
 - f. Letter of Transfer (if applicable)
 - g. Written Personal Testimony
 - h. "Discovering Your SHAPE" assignment & SHAPE Summary Profile
 - i. Verification of Baptism and CARIM Information (to be printed on certificate) online form
 - j. Church Membership Manual Reading Declaration
